Badminton divisionals are next week with the final 8 the following week. Players have shown a lot of improvement throughout the season!

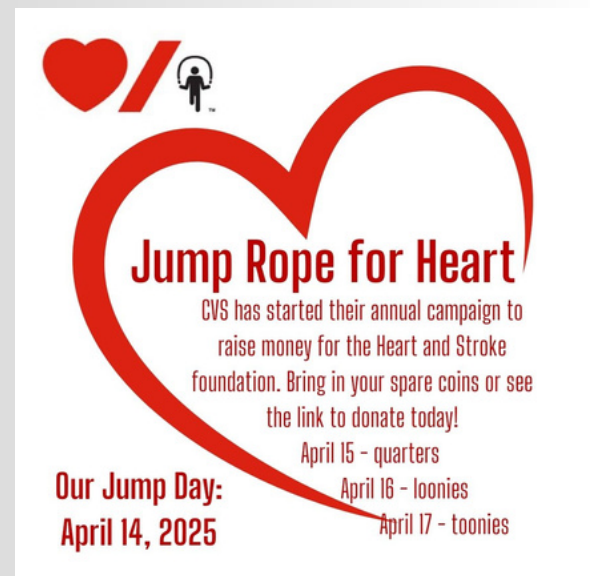
Active kids club for grade 5-6 badminton will start up in a couple weeks. A sign-up sheet will be posted for that next week.
